#### Overtime

Any work in excess of eight hours in one workday and any work in excess of 40 hours in any one workweek and the first eight hours worked on the seventh day of work in any one workweek shall be compensated at the rate of one and one-half times the Basic Hourly Rate. Any work in excess of 12 hours in one day shall be compensated at the rate of twice the Basic Hourly Rate. In addition, any work in excess of eight hours on any seventh day of a workweek shall be compensated at twice the Basic Hourly Rate.
